

FLOOD PLAIN MEETING PSA 11/12/0

Preliminary FEMA flood plain maps for Lewis and Clark County, Helena and East Helena will be presented to the public for review on Tuesday night, 6:30 p.m., on November 18 in the East Valley Fire Hall at 2694 Valley Dr.

A modernization program produced the maps in a standard digital format that will provide for up to date information on flood risk for the mapped flood plains in our area.

The preliminary maps, once adopted, will replace the current flood plain maps, some of which date back to 1981. Federal, state, private and local officials will be available to explain the maps and to answer questions.

The meeting is the start of a year long adoption process, which will include a 90 day public comment period for appeals and protests.

Again, the meeting is Tuesday night, November 18, at 6:30 p.m. in the East Valley Fire Hall, 2694 Valley Dr.
